1. Which Indian cricketer died at the age of 71 after a long battle with cancer?

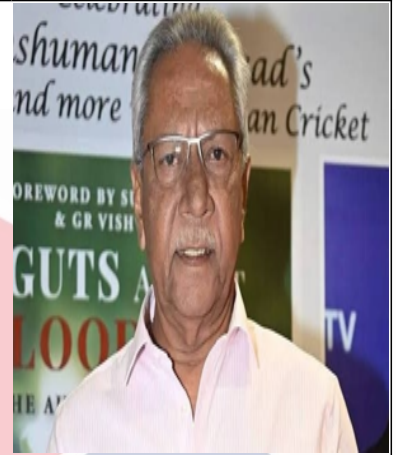

Gaekwad played 40 Tests and 15 ODIs for India from 1975 to 1987. He scored 1985 runs in Tests and 269 runs in ODIs. He also played 205 first-class matches in a career spanning 22 years. Gaekwad also served as the coach of Team India in 1997-99 and 2000 and was also a national selector.
