The app provides information and forecast related to the flood situation in the country in real time for up to 7 days. Its first version was released on August 17, 2023, and the now launched version 2.0 comes with advanced features.



2. PR Sreejesh becomes new head coach of junior men's hockey team

Hockey India (HI) has announced that retired goalkeeper PR Sreejesh has been appointed as the new head coach of the Indian junior men's hockey team. The announcement was made on August 8, 2024, when India won the bronze medal at the Paris Olympics by defeating Spain 2-1. Sreejesh's crucial saves contributed significantly to this victory. This transition of Sreejesh from player to coach is an important milestone in his career.

The mission aims to design and develop a microsatellite, compatible payload equipment, and incorporate new technologies required for future operational satellites. The EOS-08 satellite is built on the Microsat/IMS-1 bus and carries three critical payloads:




7. Wing Commander Vernon Desmond Keane VM awarded 'Shaurya Chakra' I

Wing Commander Vernon Desmond Keane, posted as a flying pilot in a fighter squadron, faced unprecedented technical problems during a crucial flight on a Jaguar fighter aircraft on 24 July 2023. During the flight he experienced oil 1 and oil 2 failure warnings, indicating a major oil system malfunction. This situation required immediate shutdown of both engines, which had never happened before and there was no standard action prescribed for it.



8. Sandeep Paundrik takes over as Secretary, Ministry of Steel

Shri Sandeep Paundrik has taken over as Secretary, Ministry of Steel. He has been posted in his new role at Udyog Bhawan. Paundrik, a 1993 batch IAS officer of Bihar cadre, was welcomed by senior officials of the Ministry.


