1. Atishi Marlena is the new Chief Minister of Delhi.

The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) has confirmed Atishi's name as the next Chief Minister of Delhi. In the Legislature Party meeting, Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal proposed Atishi's name, which was unanimously accepted. Atishi will become the third woman Chief Minister of Delhi; the post has been held by Sushma Swaraj and Sheila Dixit before her.



2. Central government approves DBT's Bio-Ride scheme.

The central government has approved the 'Biotechnology Research Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development (Bio-Ride)' scheme of the Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science and Technology. The scheme will continue for the period of the 15th Finance Commission from 2021-22 to 2025-26, and a proposed budget of Rs 9197 crore has been kept for it.



3. Cabinet approves One Nation, One Election.

The Modi Cabinet has approved the plan of 'One Nation One Election', under which the process of conducting Lok Sabha and Assembly elections simultaneously across the country will be started. For this initiative, a high-level committee was formed under the chairmanship of former President Ram Nath Kovind, which submitted its report to the Modi Cabinet, which was approved unanimously.



4. Indian Space Station: First module of India's space station approved.

The Government of India has approved the construction of the first module of the Indian Space Station (BAS-1), expanding the scope of its Gaganyaan mission. Under this decision, the country's first space station will be established by 2035, which is an important milestone in India's space ambitions. Along with this, Indian landing on the Moon has also been planned by 2040.



5. Airtel Payments Bank appoints Kumar as Chief Compliance Officer.

Airtel Payments Bank has recently appointed Amar Kumar Kakarlapudi as its new Chief Compliance Officer (CO). Amar Kumar Kakarlapudi will now be responsible for strengthening the bank's compliance framework and ensuring that all regulatory and statutory requirements are fully met. His duties will include playing a key role in achieving core and non-core compliance standards and creating an important interface between the bank and regulatory agencies.



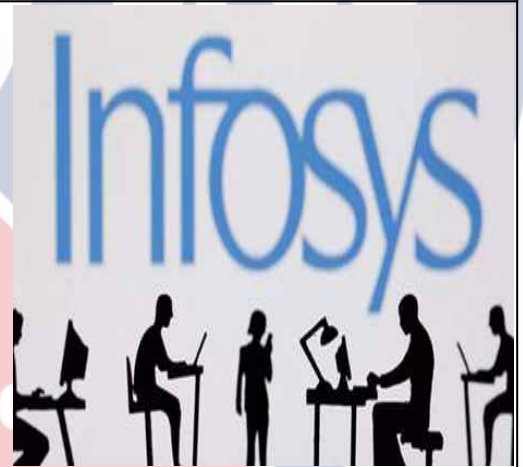
6. Cabinet approves Pradhan Mantri Janjati Unnat Gram Abhiyan.

The Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved the Pradhan Mantri Janjati Unnat Gram Abhiyan for socio-economic improvement of tribal-dominated villages. The total outlay of the scheme will be Rs 79,156 crore, including central share of Rs 56,333 crore and state share of Rs 22,823 crore. About 63,000 villages will be covered under this campaign, benefiting more than 5 crore tribal people.



7. Infosys collaborates with UK's Metro Bank to digitise operations.

Indian IT giant Infosys has announced a long-term collaboration with UK-based community bank Metro Bank to accelerate its digital transformation. Under this partnership, Infosys will use Topaz, a suite of AI-first offerings. The main objective is to enhance Metro Bank's digital capabilities, including improving automation, refining data use, and embedding advanced AI features.



8. ICICI Bank partners with PFRDA - launches NPS Vatsalya, a pension account for minors.

ICICI Bank has announced the launch of NPS Vatsalya, a pension programme to secure the financial future of children, at its service centre in BKC, Mumbai. The initiative is part of the new pension programme introduced under the Union Budget 2024-2025, which will be operated under the supervision of the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA).

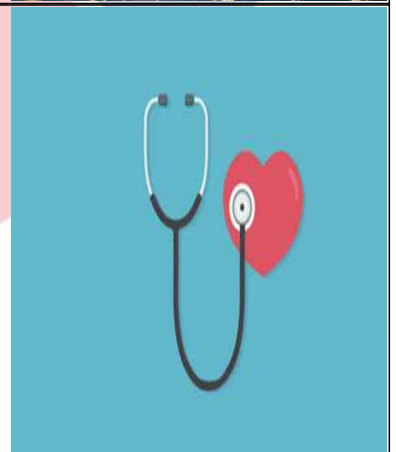
