3. India-Vietnam joint military exercise begins in Ambala.

Till now, the process of bank guarantee required physical stamping and signatures, but this new facility will use e-stamping and e-signatures.

The day highlights the importance of imaging techniques such as X-rays, CT scans, MRIs and fluoroscopy, which help in diagnosing and treating diseases.
