1. Royal Enfield launches EV brand “Flying Flea”.

Royal Enfield has unveiled its much-awaited electric vehicle (EV) brand “Flying Flea”, inspired by the company’s iconic model. The original Flying Flea, designed for military use in the 1940s, is now being reinvented by Royal Enfield as electric motorcycles. The company has introduced two new electric models – FF-C6 and FF-S6, which will be available on the roads by 2026.

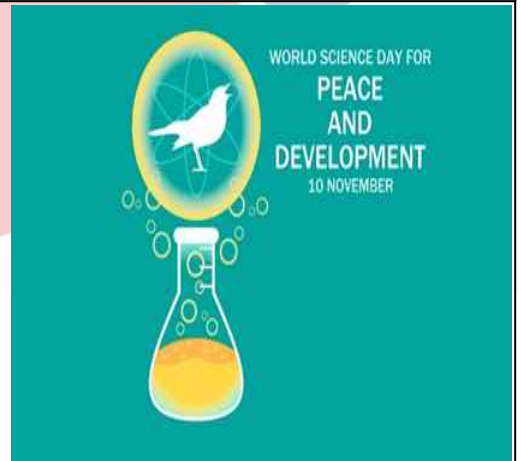
3. Mandeep Jangra wins WBF world title.

Indian professional boxer Mandeep Jangra recently won the World Boxing Federation (WBF) super featherweight world title by defeating Britain’s Conor McIntosh in the Cayman Islands. The 31-year-old Jangra performed brilliantly in this match and dominated most of the rounds. During the bout, Jangra landed powerful punches and maintained his stamina for the entire 10 rounds, while British boxer McIntosh struggled to keep up the pace.

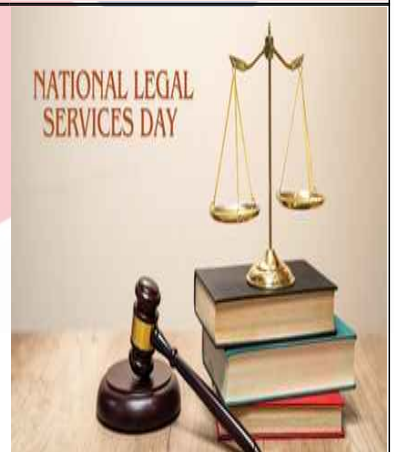
