1. 13-year-old Vaibhav Suryavanshi becomes youngest player in IPL history.

13-year-old Bihar cricketer Vaibhav Suryavanshi created history after he was signed by Rajasthan Royals for ₹1.10 crore in the IPL 2025 mega auction. He became the youngest IPL player to be selected. This achievement proved to be a significant milestone in his cricket career, establishing him as a rising star in Indian cricket.



2. Delhi government launches portal for old age pension scheme.

The Delhi government has announced the inclusion of 80,000 new senior citizens under its old age pension scheme, taking the total number of beneficiaries to 5.3 lakh now. Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal underlined the government's commitment to social welfare under the scheme in a press conference. An online portal has also been launched to make the application process simple and accessible.




3. Shivraj Singh Chouhan launches 'Naya Chetna' campaign against gender-based violence. Union Minister for Rural Development and Agriculture Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan launched the third edition of the national campaign "Naya Chetna – Pehal Badlaav Ki" in New Delhi on November 25, 2024. The campaign will run till December 23, 2024 and aims to eliminate genderbased violence, spread awareness, encourage community participation and strengthen support mechanisms for victims.



4. Dinesh Bhatia appointed as next Ambassador of India to Brazil.

Indian Foreign Service (IFS) officer Shri Dinesh Bhatia has been appointed as the next Ambassador of India to Brazil on November 25, 2024. He is a 1992 batch IFS officer and has extensive diplomatic experience. Currently, Shri Bhatia was serving as Ambassador of India to Argentina since 21 August 2019 and was also accredited as Ambassador of India to Uruguay and Paraguay till 2022.





5. Dr. Jaitirth Raghavendra Joshi appointed as the head of BrahMos Aerospace.

Dr. Jaitirth Raghavendra Joshi has been appointed as the new head of BrahMos Aerospace. BrahMos Aerospace is a joint venture between India and Russia, famous for the development of the BrahMos supersonic cruise missile. Dr Joshi has over three decades of experience in the field of missile technology, non-destructive testing (NDT) and skill development.




6. Constitution Day celebrated for the first time in Jammu and Kashmir after 1950.

On 26 November 2024, to mark the completion of 75 years of the Constitution of India, Jammu and Kashmir (J&K) celebrated Constitution Day for the first time in a grand manner. The event was aimed at highlighting the values enshrined in the Preamble of the Constitution such as justice, equality, and fraternity and symbolizing the integration of the region into the national framework.



7. India's first space Al lab.

Hyderabad-based space tech company TM2Space is set to launch India's first space-based Al laboratory, MOI-TD (My Orbital Infrastructure - Technology Demonstrator) in mid-December 2024 via ISRO's PSLV C60 rocket. The mission will enable real-time data processing in space, reducing data transmission costs and making space research accessible to a wider audience.



8. International Day of Solidarity with the Palestinian People 2024.

Every year on November 29, the International Day of Solidarity with the Palestinian People is observed by the United Nations. This day is celebrated as the anniversary of the adoption of Resolution 181 on the partition of Palestine by the General Assembly on November 29, 1947. The purpose of this day is to focus on the rights and issues of the Palestinian people, which are still unresolved today.


