1. Solar power capacity exceeds 100 GW: Union Minister Pralhad Joshi.

India has achieved a historic milestone by crossing 100 GW of installed solar power capacity, reflecting its commitment towards a clean and green future. Union Minister Shri Pralhad Joshi announced the achievement. Initiatives such as solar panels, solar parks and rooftop solar projects have played a key role in this success. PM Surya Ghar Free Electricity Scheme is promoting rooftop solar power.



2. Aero India 2025

Aero India is Asia's largest air show, organized by the Defense Exhibition Organization, Department of Defense Production and Ministry of Defense in Bengaluru. This biennial air show is a major platform for the showcase of global aero vendors and the Indian Air Force. The event brings together aerospace and defence sector stalwarts, government officials and experts.



3. BIMSTEC Youth Summit 2025 in Gandhinagar.

The BIMSTEC Youth Summit 2025 will be held in Gandhinagar, Gujarat from 7 to 11 February 2025. This conference will provide a platform for young leaders of BIMSTEC countries to promote cooperation, innovation and regional development. The inauguration will be done by Union Minister Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya on 8 February 2025.



4. Panama pulls out of China's 'Belt and Road' Initiative

Panama officially announced its exit from China's Belt and Road Initiative (BRI), a major shift in its foreign policy. President José Raúl Mulino's decision reflects growing tensions between the US and China, especially over the Panama Canal. Panama joined the BRI in 2017, when it severed ties with Taiwan and established diplomatic relations with China.

5. UN General Assembly President Philemon Yang visits India.

The President of the 77th session of the United Nations General Assembly, Philemon Yang, was on an official visit to India from 4-7 February 2025. This was his first visit to India, as he was elected President of the General Assembly on 24 June 2024. He will hold the post from September 2024 to September 2025.



6. Assam to host world's largest Jhumur festival.

Assam will host the world's largest Jhumur dance performance on February 24, 2025, as part of the Advantage Assam 2.0 Investment Summit. Prime Minister Narendra Modi will be the chief guest on this historic occasion, Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma announced. More than 7,500 dancers will participate in this performance and aim to create a Guinness World Record.



7. International Arabian Leopard Day 2025.

The United Nations General Assembly declared February 10 as "International Arabian Leopard Day" under resolution 77/295, which was first celebrated in New York in 2024. It aims to raise awareness about the conservation of the endangered Arabian leopard. The Arabian leopard (*Panthera pardus nimr*) is mainly found in Saudi Arabia, Oman, UAE, Yemen, Jordan and Israel.



8. Madhav National Park

Madhav National Park has been declared the 9th Tiger Reserve of Madhya Pradesh, which will promote wildlife conservation in the Chambal region. There is a plan to expand the Madhav Tiger Reserve to 1,600 square kilometers in the next five years. Apart from this, tiger safari will be developed in 100 hectares, with an investment of Rs 20 crore, which will boost tourism and local economy.

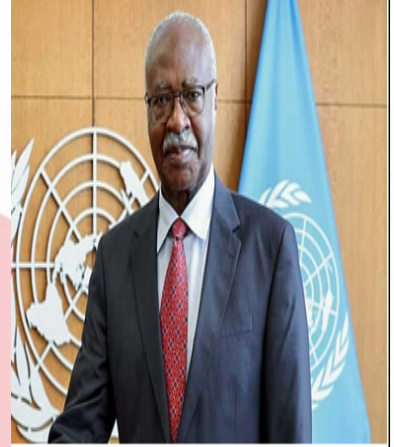

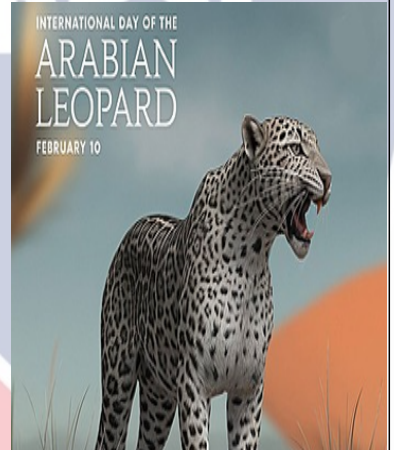
