1. Chandrashekhar Azad

The death anniversary of the great freedom fighter Chandrashekhar Azad is celebrated every year on 27 February. He was born on 23 July 1906 in Bhabra village of Madhya Pradesh. His father was Sitaram and mother was Jagrani Devi. At the age of just 15, he joined Mahatma Gandhi's non-cooperation movement. When he was arrested in Banaras during the movement, he told his name as 'Azad', due to which this name became associated with him.



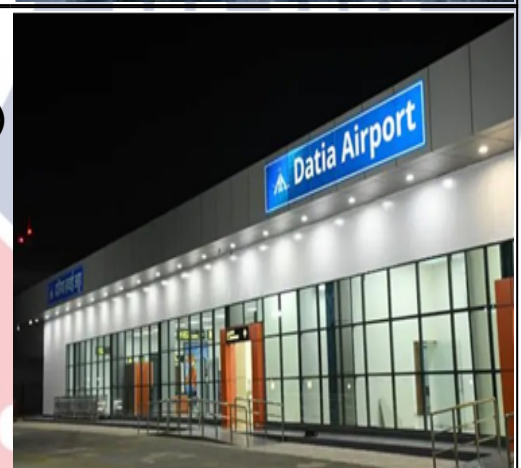
2. Warship "Tamal"

The modern multishell stealth-guided missile warship 'Tamal' will join the Indian Navy fleet in June 2025. After this, only indigenous warships will be included in the Navy. 'Tamal' is manufactured at Yantar Shipyard in Russia. In the year 2016, an agreement was signed between India and Russia to build four Talwar-class stealth frigates, out of which two were to be built in Russia and two in India.



3. Datia Airport becomes the 8th public airport of Madhya Pradesh

Recently, the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) granted public airport license to Datia Airport under the VFR category, making it the eighth public airport of Madhya Pradesh. This airport is spread over 184 acres and will provide air service to Bhopal and Khajuraho, which will promote tourism in the state.



4. America's 'Gold Card' Visa

Former US President Donald Trump has planned to launch a new 'Gold Card' visa program, which will give wealthy foreign investors the opportunity to get instant US citizenship by investing \$5 million. This new visa will replace the 35-year-old EB-5 visa, which used to get citizenship in 5-7 years on investing \$1 million.

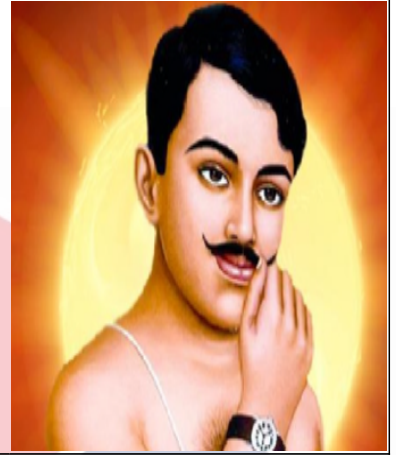
