1. International Radiobiology Conference

The Institute of Nuclear Medicine and Allied Sciences (INMAS), a laboratory of Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) located in Delhi, is organising the International Radiobiology Conference. The event was inaugurated by Professor Ajay Kumar Sood, Principal Scientific Adviser to the Government of India as the Chief Guest.

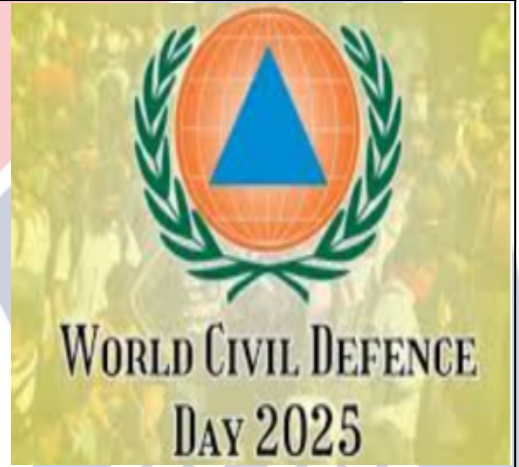
5. Strong India Magazine

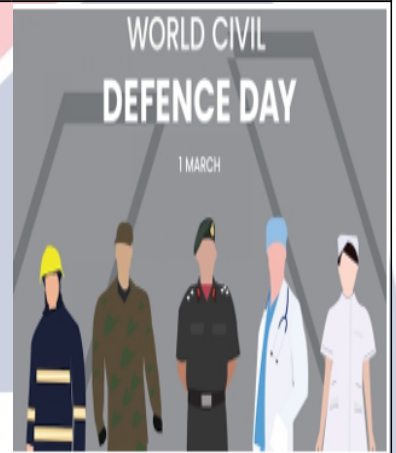
