1. Prime Minister Modi's Mauritius visit

Prime Minister Narendra Modi recently arrived in Port Louis on his two-day Mauritius tour. He participated as the chief guest in the National Day celebrations of Mauritius. This is the second time he became the chief guest at this function. Prime Minister Modi described Mauritius as a bridge to the Global South and emphasized on further strengthening the economic and strategic partnership of the two countries.



2. Chief Minister Kanya Atmanirbhar Yojana

Recently, the Tripura government has launched the "Chief Minister Balika Samridhi Yojana" and "Chief Minister Kanya Atmanirbhar Yojana". "Chief Minister Balika Samridhi Yojana" is for girls living below the poverty line (BPL). The state government will deposit a bond of Rs 50,000 in the name of the girl child, which will be provided on completion of 18 years of age.



3. Freedom fighter 'Chintu Pandey's memorial will be built in Ballia

Recently, the Uttar Pradesh government announced to build a memorial in honor of freedom fighter Chintu Pandey in Ballia. Chintu Pandey was a great freedom fighter who played an important role in the Quit India Movement of 1942. He was known as the "Sher of Ballia". He was born on 10 May 1865 in Ballia district of Uttar Pradesh.



4. AAHAR – 2025

The Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA) showcased excellence in India's agro-processed food products at the 39th edition of AAHAR 2025. APEDA participated in the event held at Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi, which was organized by the India Trade Promotion Organization (ITPO). Soil fertility maps have been prepared for 351 villages in 34 districts of Maharashtra, which provide detailed information on the nutrient composition and health of the soil.



7. JKIM and AAC declared unlawful organisations

The Government of India has declared "Jammu and Kashmir Ittehadul Muslimeen" (JKIM) and "Awami Action Committee" (AAC) as unlawful organisations for 5 years under Section 3(1) of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA) 1967. This ban has been imposed as they were found to be involved in activities against the peace, law and sovereignty of the country.



8. Successful test of ASTRA missile from Tejas MK1 prototype

The Indian Aeronautical Development Agency (ADA) successfully tested the indigenous Astra Beyond Visual Range Air to Air Missile. The missile was fired from the Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) Tejas AF MK1 prototype near Chandipur coast of Odisha. This test proved the accuracy and advanced capabilities of the missile, which is considered a significant achievement towards strengthening India's indigenous defense system.

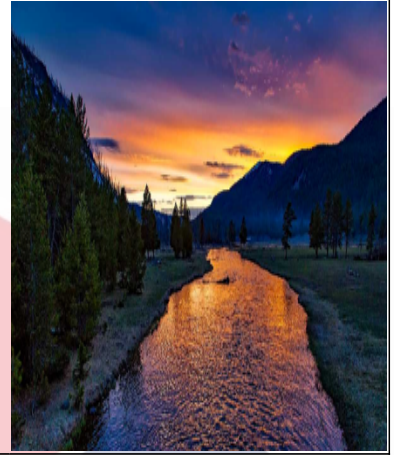
