1. Our Tradition - Our Heritage

A one-day national level program was organized in New Delhi under the "Our Tradition - Our Heritage" initiative. It was organized by the Ministry of Panchayati Raj in collaboration with the Panchayati Raj Department of the Government of Jharkhand. The program took place in the Rang Bhavan Auditorium of the Akashvani Bhavan complex. It was inaugurated by Panchayati Raj Minister S.P. Singh Baghel.



2. Startup Mahakumbh

"Startup Mahakumbh 2025" is being organized from 3 April to 5 April at Bharat Mandapam, Pragati Maidan, New Delhi. It is considered to be India's largest startup event till date. Its objective is to present India's startup ecosystem on a global platform and provide opportunities for innovation, investment and networking. This mega event is being organized in collaboration with Startup India, Invest India and industry organizations like NASSCOM and TIE.



3. 'Jal Jeevan Mission' - Tap water supply to more than 80% of rural households in the country

Jal Jeevan Mission was launched in August 2019 with the aim of providing clean drinking water through taps to rural families. At that time only 3.23 crore (16%) rural families had tap connections. As of March 20, 2025, tap water connections have been provided to about 12.30 crore additional rural families. Now out of the total 19.36 crore rural families in the country, 15.53 crore (80.22%) families are getting tap water supply.



4. Prime Minister Narendra Modi was awarded Sri Lanka's highest civilian honour - Mithra Vibhushan.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi was awarded Sri Lanka's highest civilian honour "Mithra Vibhushan" for his contribution in strengthening the historical and friendly relations between India and Sri Lanka. The award was presented by Sri Lankan President Anura Kumara Dissanayake during a ceremony held at the Presidential Secretariat in Colombo. This honour is considered a symbol of deep friendship and cooperation between the two countries.

5. India won 6 medals at World Boxing Cup Brazil-2025.

The Indian boxing contingent won a total of six medals with one gold, one silver and four bronze medals in the first stage of the World Boxing Cup Brazil 2025. The competition was held in Foz do Iguacu, Brazil from 31 March to 5 April. Hitesh Gulia created history by winning the gold medal and became the first Indian boxer to do so. Hitesh got a walkover due to England's Odell Kamara's injury in the 70 kg category final.



6. Bangladesh took over the chairmanship of BIMSTEC for the next two years.

On 4 April 2025, Bangladesh officially took over the chairmanship of BIMSTEC. It has got this responsibility from the previous chairman Thailand. Bangladesh Chief Advisor Muhammad Yunus assumed the chairmanship. The full name of BIMSTEC is Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation. This organization is a group of seven countries bordering the Bay of Bengal



7. Sudarshan Patnaik: First Indian to receive Fred Darrington Sand Master Award

Famous sand artist from Odisha Sudarshan Patnaik created history by winning the Fred Darrington Award at the Sandworld International Sand Art Festival held in Weymouth, England. He has become the first Indian to win this award. This award was given to him for his 10 meter high sand sculpture of Lord Ganesha. The festival was held in Dorset, England from 5 to 9 April 2025.



8. Anant Nagar Yojana

Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath launched the Anant Nagar Yojana of "Lucknow Development Authority" (LDA) in Lucknow on 4 April 2025. The scheme has been launched with the aim of providing world-class residential facilities in the city. Anant Nagar Yojana is spread over an area of about 785 acres and is being developed at a cost of Rs 10,000 crore. Residential plots will be made available for different income groups under the scheme.

Jal Jeevan Mission was launched in August 2019 to provide clean drinking water from tap to rural families. Then only 16% of rural families had tap connection, which has increased to 80.22% (15.53 crore families) by 20 March 2025. So far 12.30 crore new connections have been given under the mission. 11 states / union territories have become "Har Ghar Jal".
