1. Roshni Nadar becomes 5th richest woman in the world

Roshni Nadar, Chairperson of HCL Technologies, became the first Indian woman to be included in the top 10 richest women in the world in the Hurun Global Rich List 2025. Her net worth is estimated at ₹3.5 lakh crore, making her the wealthiest woman in India and the third richest person in the country. This achievement came after her father Shiv Nadar transferred 47% stake in HCL Technologies, further strengthening his financial position.



2. Sahakar Taxi Service

Union Home Minister Amit Shah announced in the Lok Sabha that the government will soon launch the 'Sahakar Taxi' service. It aims to directly benefit taxi, bike and auto-rickshaw drivers and provide affordable transport facilities to passengers. This service will increase the income of drivers as their earnings will reach them directly, without any middlemen.



3. India's 'Nuclear Mission'

Under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, India has launched the 'Nuclear Mission', which aims to provide clean and environmentally friendly energy. Under this mission, a target of producing 100 gigawatts of nuclear power by 2047 has been set, which will be 10% of the country's total energy needs. For the first time, the government has opened the nuclear sector to private companies, which will promote investment and technological innovation.



4. Nag Missile System

The Defence Ministry approved a defence deal worth Rs 2,500 crore to strengthen the capabilities of the Indian Armed Forces. The deal includes the purchase of Nag Missile System (NAMIS) tracked version and 5,000 light vehicles. The Nag missile system was contracted with Armoured Vehicles Nigam Limited, while Force Motors Limited and Mahindra & Mahindra Limited were contracted for the supply of light vehicles.

5. PM Modi announces theme for International Yoga Day 2025

Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced the theme for International Yoga Day (IDY) 2025 as "Yoga for One Earth - One Health" in the "Mann Ki Baat" program. He called yoga an integral part of global health and well-being and appealed to adopt it in daily life. This year, the Morarji Desai National Institute of Yoga (MDNIY) is leading the Yoga Day activities.



6. President Draupadi Murmu inaugurates National Conference on Environment 2025

President Draupadi Murmu inaugurated the National Environment Conference at Vigyan Bhavan in New Delhi on 29 March 2025, which will conclude on 30 March. Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar will address the closing session as the chief guest, while Supreme Court judge Justice P.S. Narasimha and Solicitor General Tushar Mehta will also present views.



7. Anahat Singh and Karim El Torkhi won Indian Open 2025 squash title

India's number one women's squash player Anahat Singh won the women's singles title at the Indian Open 2025 PSA Copper event held in Mumbai. This was her second consecutive win, as she had earlier won the SRFI Indian Tour PSA Challenger event in Chennai. The men's title was won by Karim El Torkhi of Egypt. The Indian Open 2025, held at the prestigious Bombay Gymkhana Courts in Mumbai from 24 to 28 March 2025, had a prize money of \$53,500.



8. 37th Kathak Mahotsav 2025

The 37th Kathak Mahotsav 2025 organized by Kathak Kendra under Sangeet Natak Akademi, New Delhi, was successfully concluded. This 6-day event holds a special place in the history of Kathak art, as it also included the "Kathak Sahitya Mahotsav" for the first time. The festival featured seminars, exhibitions and mesmerizing dance performances, in which leading artists from Lucknow, Jaipur, Banaras and Raigarh Gharanas gave their performances.

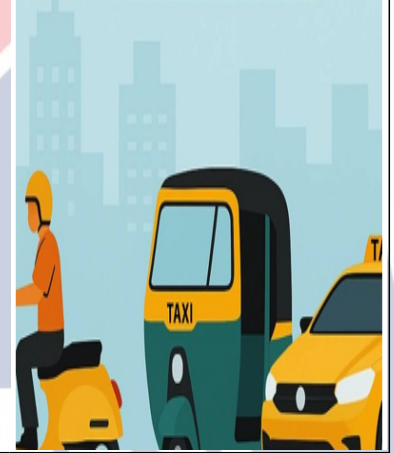

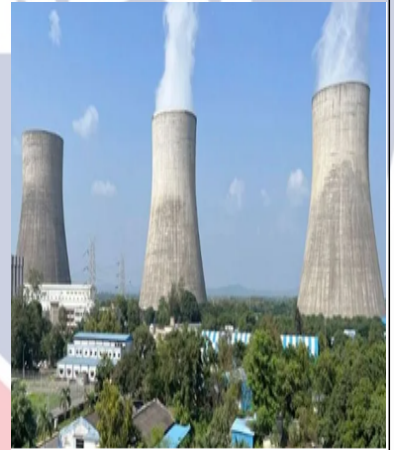
